Luke 12:16-21
1 Cor. 13

“Thus will it be for anyone who stores up treasure for himself but is not rich in what matters to God.” (Luke 12:21)

I. If I Don't Live A Life Of Love:

- A. Nothing I say will matter. (Ref. 1 Cor. 13:1)
- B. Nothing I know will matter. (Ref. 1 Cor. 13:2)
- C. Nothing I believe will matter. (Ref. 1 Cor. 13:2)
- D. Nothing I give will matter. (Ref. 1 Cor. 13:3)
- E. Nothing I accomplish will matter. (Ref. 1 Cor. 13:3)

II. What Is Love?

- A. Love is a command; not a feeling. (Ref. 2 John 1:6)
 - You can exist without love but you can't live without love.
- B. Love is a choice; not something you say. (Ref. 1 Cor. 14:1)
- C. Love is a conduct; it's something you do. (Ref. 1 John 3:18)
- D. Love is a commitment. (Ref. 1 John 4:16)

III. How Do You Build A Life Of Love?

A. Start this month by:

1. Learn how mature love acts & responds.
2. Start your day with a daily reminder to love.
3. Read what God says about love.
4. Practice acting in unselfish, loving ways.
5. Get support from other loving people. (Ref. Ephesians 5:2)
